Dear Mr. Henkel:

The State Board of Elections & Ethics Enforcement, pursuant to N.C.G.S. §163-278.34(a), is required to assess a late filing penalty at the rate of \$50.00 per day, not to exceed \$500.00 for a report affecting non-statewide elections or \$250.00 per day, not to exceed \$10,000.00 for a report affecting statewide elections. Since this report does not appear to affect a statewide election, the rate of \$50.00 per day applies and a late filing penalty of \$250.00 - waived per non-filed or late filed report has been assessed for the following report:
