#### Scope

A federal political committee, as defined by the Federal Election Campaign Act and the regulations adopted pursuant thereto, is permitted to make contributions to a North Carolina candidate or North Carolina political committee provided that the contributing federal political committee complies with the requirements of G.S. 163-278.7A.

Federal Political Committees registered with the North Carolina State Board of Elections are examined to determine whether reports filed with the State Board conform to state law and the truth. N.C.G.S. § 163-278.24.

This memorandum summarizes findings made by program analysts. All committees are notified prior to publication of this memorandum of any prohibited transactions or reporting errors identified during the examination. N.C.G.S. § 163-278.23.

The scope of any examination is limited to a review of the actual reports filed with the North Carolina State Board of Elections. As part of an examination, a program analyst may request to inspect bank statements or other account information maintained by the committee's treasurer to determine conformity with state law and the accuracy of the report. N.C.G.S. § 163-278.8.

There is no activity in the Reports filed; therefore, no transaction issues were identified as detailed below.

Program Analysts evaluate each report for prohibited transactions, reporting errors, and informational items. Issues identified during the examination are noted below.

### **Prohibited Transactions**

Reports are checked for possible prohibited transactions. These are transactions that involve unlawful contributions under North Carolina law. The State Board will seek forfeiture of all prohibited transactions. The State Board may also pursue civil penalties pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 163-278.34.

Required Action	Reported Contributions to NC Candidates and Committees appear to exceed the maximum contribution limit. If the contribution limit was exceeded, the State Board will seek a forfeiture of the amount contributed over the limit. If limits have not been exceeded, documentation related to the expense of these transactions must be provided.

Contributions made by PAC's with a Registered Lobbyist, made during Legislative Session (NC Senate, NC House, Council of State only)		N.C.G.S. § 163-278.13B

Required Action	Each transaction is researched to determine the actual expense date. If the federal political committee or its parent entity employs or contracts a registered lobbyist and has reported making expenses during a regular session the State Board will seek a forfeiture of the expense. If the incorrect date is recorded, any change to dates must be supported by documentation. A copy of each check must be provided.
